A Story of Impact: Miranda's story is one of resilience, courage, and the unbreakable bond of a mother's love. At 31 years old, she found herself facing the unthinkable - becoming homeless alongside her two precious daughters, Emily, and Kendra. Their story begins when Miranda receives a notice that her family will be evicted from their home. Thankfully, Miranda and her two girls were able to seek refuge with family members, in hopes of regaining stability. However, despite her relentless efforts to secure employment and housing, fate had different plans.

The family where Miranda and her girls were staying set a deadline for them to find a home, but with the housing crisis and increased rental rates that deadline came and went without any viable options for her family. So, the family of three had no other option but to sleep in their car.

With unwavering determination, Miranda continued her search and discovered Dawning Family Services. It was a turning point in her life - a pivotal moment that brought not just aid but also a promise of a brighter future for her family.

Yet, the road to stability was not without hardships. Miranda faced countless challenges concerning childcare assistance which prevented her from securing a full-time job. The weight of responsibility bore heavy on her shoulders, but she would do anything for her girls.

Dawning Family Services became Miranda's pillar of support. Through their intervention, she received an Early Learning Center referral, ensuring her children were cared for while she navigated the harsh world of job hunting.

Then, success finally came her way. With Dawning Family Services' guidance, Miranda embraced an employment opportunity with open arms. Despite the hurdles, she persevered, demonstrating her steadfast determination to create a better life for her family. As her new opportunity was a bigger commute, DFS assisted Miranda with transportation to ensure her success in this new position.

The journey continued as she transitioned into their shelter while awaiting approval for apartments she had applied for earlier, through the support of DFS' Housing and Support Specialists. The day finally came as she was approved for an apartment of her own. Dawning Family Services empowered Miranda to stand on her own feet. Supporting her with move-in costs and referring her for furniture assistance, transforming an empty space into a warm, welcoming home for her daughters.

Miranda's resilience knew no bounds. She secured employment, found stable housing, was approved for a childcare center, and was provided furniture for their new home. Miranda and her two daughters are stably housed in a place that they can call their own.

So, in 2005 after a long history of informal giving, the clinic established the Foundation of Caring (FOC), a nonprofit charitable organization dedicated to helping others.

Intended to be a catalyst for community change, FOC was created to be a one-stop resource for your philanthropic efforts. By collectively pooling our resources, we unite people, businesses and organizations that have the passion needed to create lasting transformation in our community.

Together, we can impact a variety of worthwhile community focused projects and programs. FOC, unlike most medical foundations, does not use any of the donated funds to support or enhance clinic activities. Currently, nearly 94% of the monies raised goes back into our community to provide hope, opportunities and solutions to those who need it most.

Our competitive grant process allows charitable organizations in Hillsborough and Pasco counties to work jointly with the Foundation in order to enrich lives and create immediate and ongoing positive change. With your support over the last 19 years, we have stocked food pantries so families could eat, provided prescription funding for uninsured patients, ensured foster kids had a safe place to sleep, underwritten costs of accessibility upgrades to support people with disabilities now aging in place and much more.

To date, together, we have reinvested over \$4.0 million dollars in 195 local nonprofit organizations. And, with your support of this event, we can continue to make a more meaningful and long-lasting impact in our community.
