

And because each charity we support is carefully vetted by our Board of Directors, you can trust that your generosity will go where it's needed most, making the greatest possible impact.



What makes the Foundation of Caring truly special is its focus. Unlike most medical foundations, FOC doesn't use donated funds to enhance clinical operations. Instead, nearly 94% of all donations are re-invested directly into the community, touching lives through local nonprofits.

The Faces of our Inspiration



Layla's House Surrounded by instability and searching for support, Isiah and Teisha found connection, education, and community at Layla's House. Initially introduced to Champions for Children through parent-child programs, their engagement deepened around the birth of their third child, Josiah. At a time when their family was facing multiple stressors, Layla's House and Champions' continuum of support, including prenatal education, newborn care resources, and fatherhood programming, provided a critical foundation.

Through participation in parenting workshops and father-focused groups, Isiah found the positive male support network he had long been seeking. Together, the couple built a confidence in their parenting, strengthened their relationship, and gained tools to build a more stable home for their children. Today, Isiah and Teisha are active ambassadors of Champions' programs, including Layla's House, and committed to helping other families find the same strength and community they discovered. ▼




Crossroads for Florida Kids "John" is a 17-year-old adopted youth referred to Juvenile Mental Health Court. Initially resistant to authority and struggling with trauma, he faced delinquency charges that threatened his future. Crossroads' attorneys built trust, provided unwavering support and helped him with his case plan. With grant-funded assistance for school, transportation, and daily needs, he successfully completed his requirements, resulting in dismissal of his charges and a clean record. Today, he is repairing family relationships,

catching up academically, and working nearly full-time. His transformation demonstrates how legal advocacy combined with basic-needs support can change the trajectory of a young person's life.


